

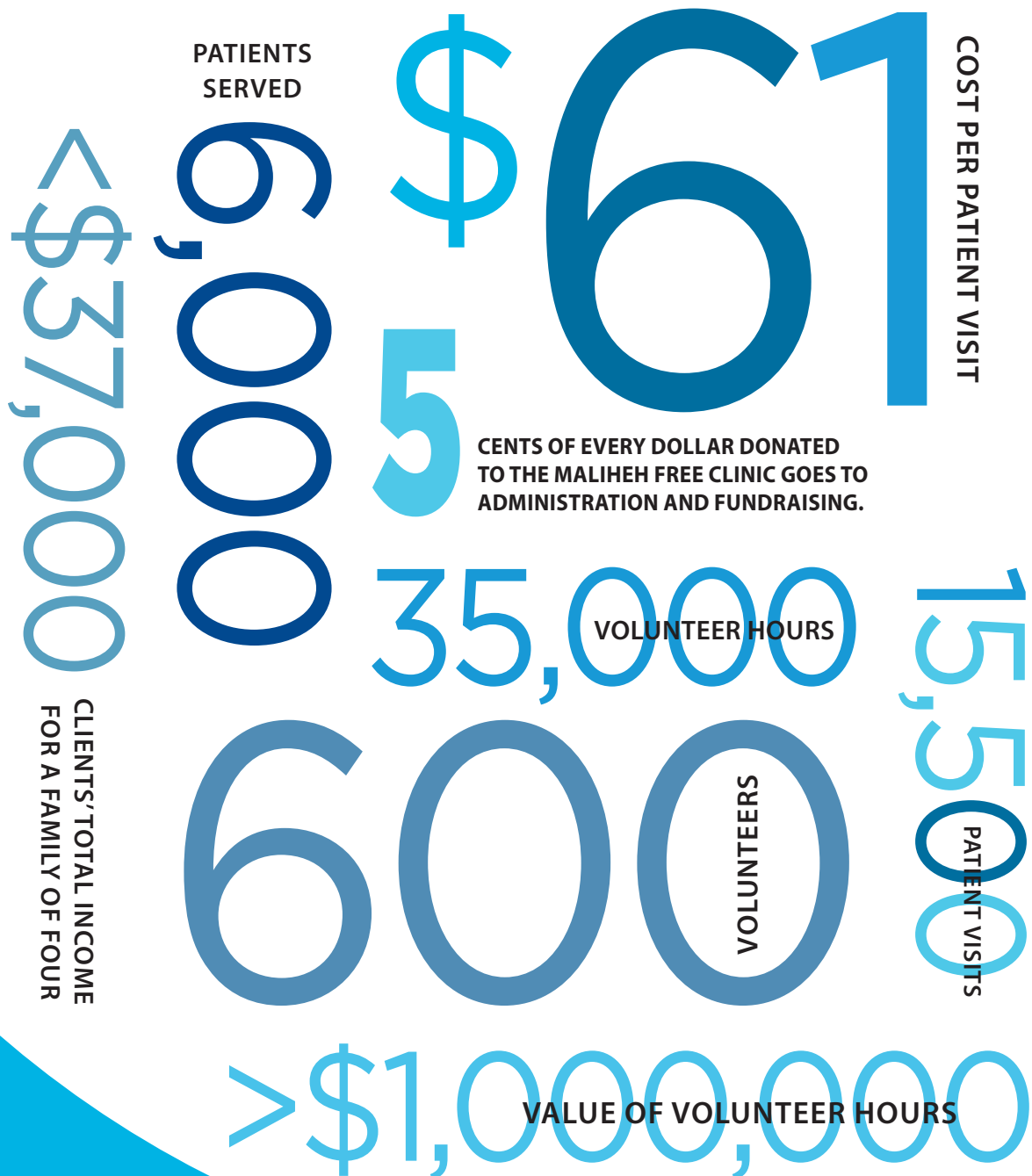

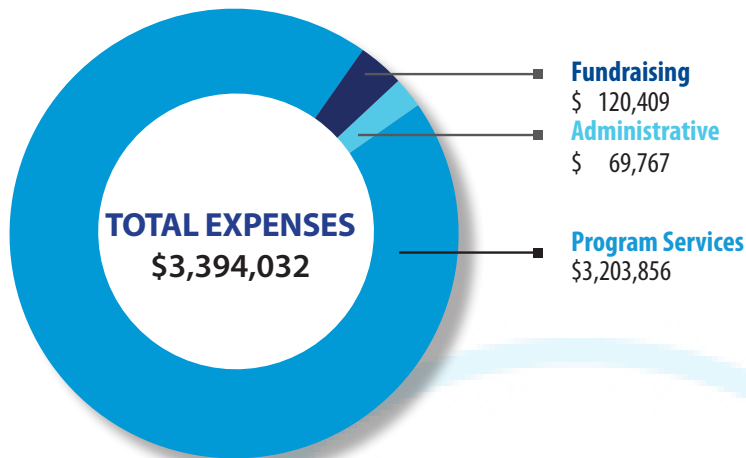
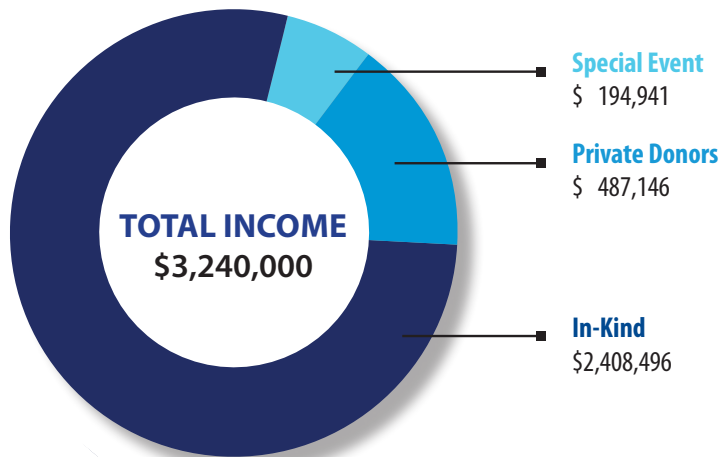
## ANNUAL CLINIC STATISTICS
