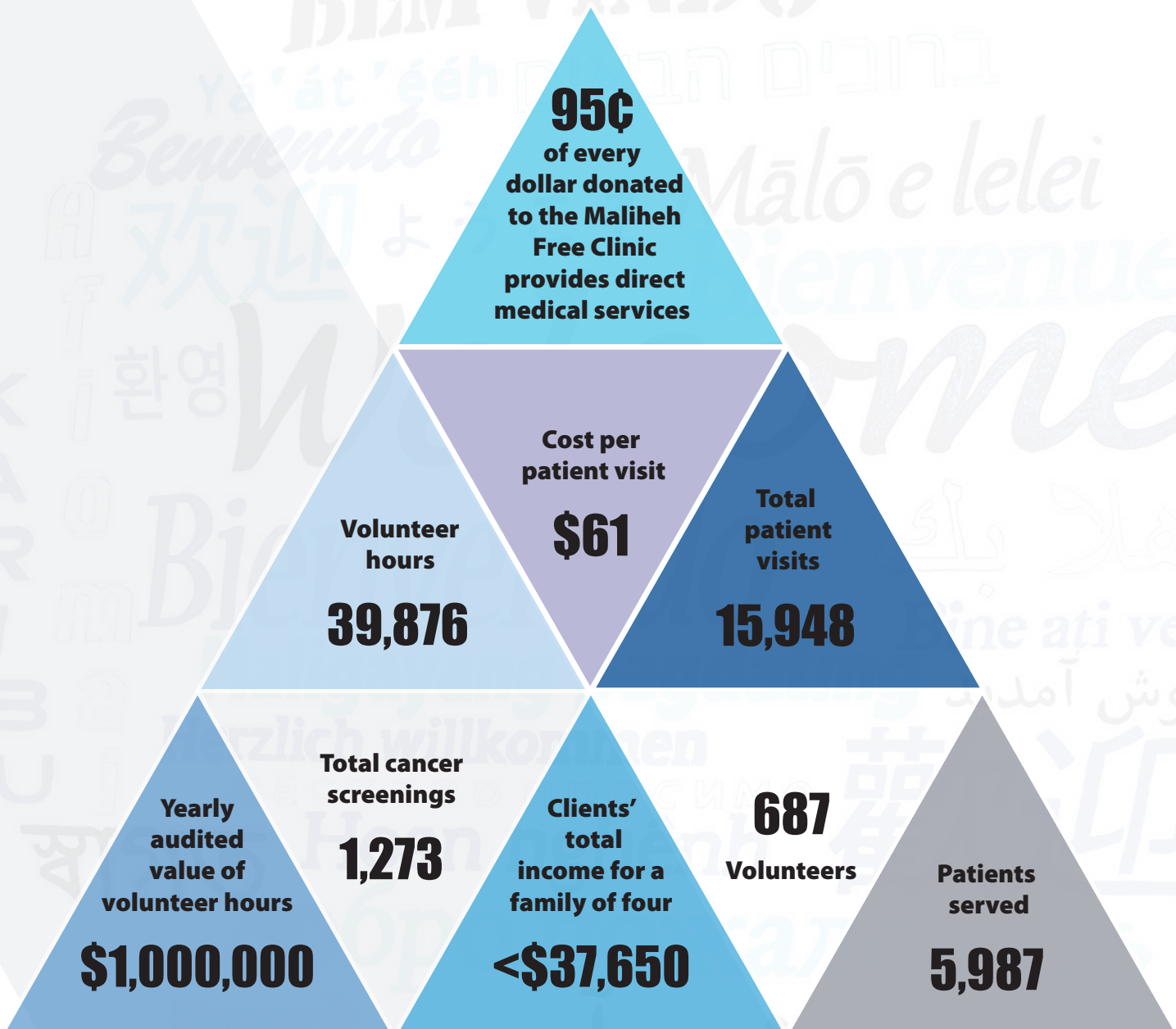

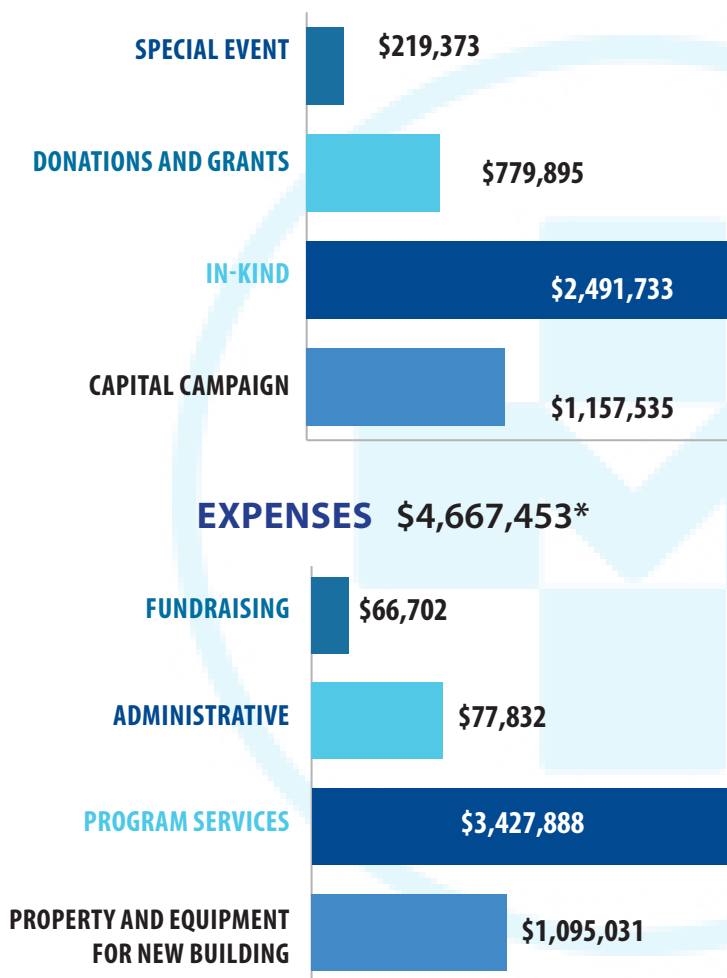


OUR MISSION

"VOLUNTEERS ARE THE HEART

Volunteers are the heart and soul of our clinic. Last year, the clinic had 687 volunteers donate 39,876 service hours! Since 2005, our volunteers have donated well over 300,000 service hours. Our volunteers include: medical professionals, doctors, nurses, PAs, MAs, physical therapists, ophthalmologists, counselors, social workers, interpreters, and clerical staff.

Through the care provided by our volunteers, nearly 40,000 Utahns have been served through 200,000 unique patient visits since 2005. Without our volunteers, the clinic would be unable to provide the quality of care that is needed by the most vulnerable in our community.
