About the Clinic >

Since 2005, the Maliheh Free Clinic has provided free medical services to uninsured Utahns. Maliheh serves those below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines who do not have health insurance.

The clinic is staffed by over 450 active volunteers including physicians, physician assistants, nurses, techs, interpreters, and clerical staff. It is through their selfless service that we are able to provide healthcare access to uninsured Utahns.

Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteers at Maliheh are required to volunteer twice monthly for a minimum of four months. Each volunteer opportunity has the potential to develop into trainer and leadership positions.

> Patient Tech

Use your CNA, MA, EMT, or equivalent certification to prepare patients for their visit with their medical providers.

> Spanish interpreter

Facilitate conversations between patients and their medical providers. Medical Spanish is taught by our leadership teams.

> Office Volunteer

Volunteer side-by-side with Maliheh staff members helping patients check in for their appointments. Available to volunteers ages 16 and up.

> Resource and Medication Assistance

Help patients receive discounted services at Intermountain Healthcare and free medications.
