The mission of the Maliheh Free Clinic is to provide free, same-day access to high-quality urgent medical care for all qualified patients. The Maliheh Free Clinic was founded with the sole purpose of rescuing those members of our community who are in the most critical need of our help.

OVERVIEW



SERVICES PROVIDED

The Maliheh Free Clinic provides a comprehensive range of medical services to individuals in need. Our services include but are not limited to:

1. **Primary Care:** MFC offers general medical care, including preventive services, routine check-ups, and management of chronic conditions.
2. **Urgent Care:** MFC provides timely medical attention for non-emergency conditions, addressing immediate health concerns.
3. **Specialty Care:** When necessary, MFC refers patients to specialists to ensure appropriate specialty care.
4. **Medication Assistance:** MFC helps eligible patients access affordable medications through pharmaceutical assistance programs and medication samples.
5. **Laboratory and Diagnostic Services:** MFC facilitates access to necessary laboratory tests and diagnostic procedures to aid in diagnosis and treatment planning.
6. **Health Education:** MFC offers educational resources and guidance on health promotion, disease prevention, and self-management of medical conditions.
7. **Referrals to Community Resources:** MFC connects patients with additional support services, such as social services, mental health resources, and other community programs.

Our dedicated healthcare professionals and volunteers work together to provide comprehensive and compassionate care, addressing the specific needs of each individual we serve.

WHO WE SERVE

The Maliheh Free Clinic serves a diverse range of individuals in need of medical care. Our services are available to those who are uninsured and have incomes up to 250% of the federal poverty level. This includes low-income individuals and families who may face financial barriers in accessing healthcare. We prioritize assisting underserved populations, including but not limited to individuals from ethnic and religious minorities, people of color, immigrants, refugees, women, and individuals with diverse gender identities and sexual orientations. Our goal is to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or circumstances, has access to quality healthcare services and can achieve better health outcomes.

2022 VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers are the lifeblood of Maliheh Free Clinic's operations. In the past year, a remarkable total of 910 volunteers gave generously of their time, contributing 28,219 hours of service. Our ongoing tally since 2005 shows a profound commitment from our volunteers, with an astonishing 440,000 service hours donated. Our volunteer roster is diverse and dedicated, encompassing doctors, nurses, physician assistants, medical assistants, physical therapists, interpreters, and clerical staff. Their collective efforts have facilitated healthcare provision to over 48,000 Utah residents through 245,000 unique patient visits since our inception in 2005. Without the selfless dedication of our volunteers, it would be impossible for the clinic to deliver the high standard of care that our community's most vulnerable members require and deserve.

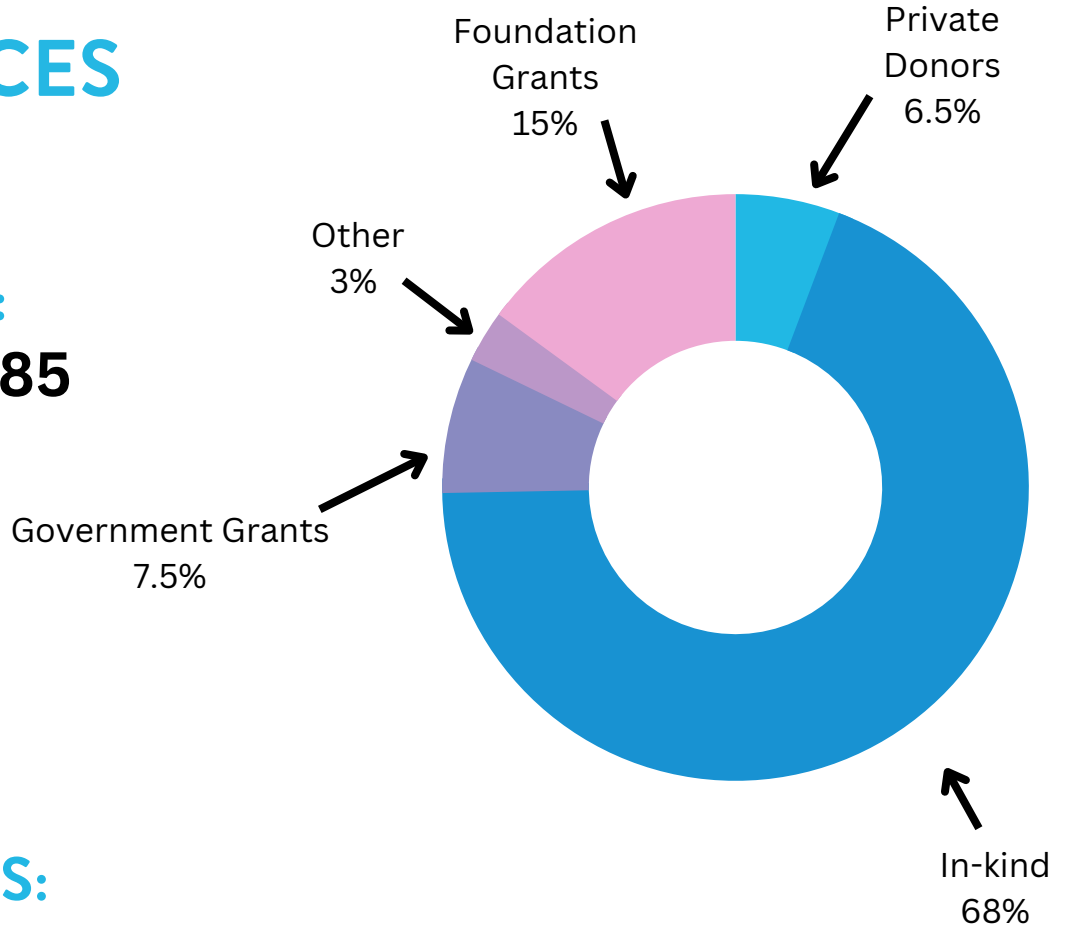

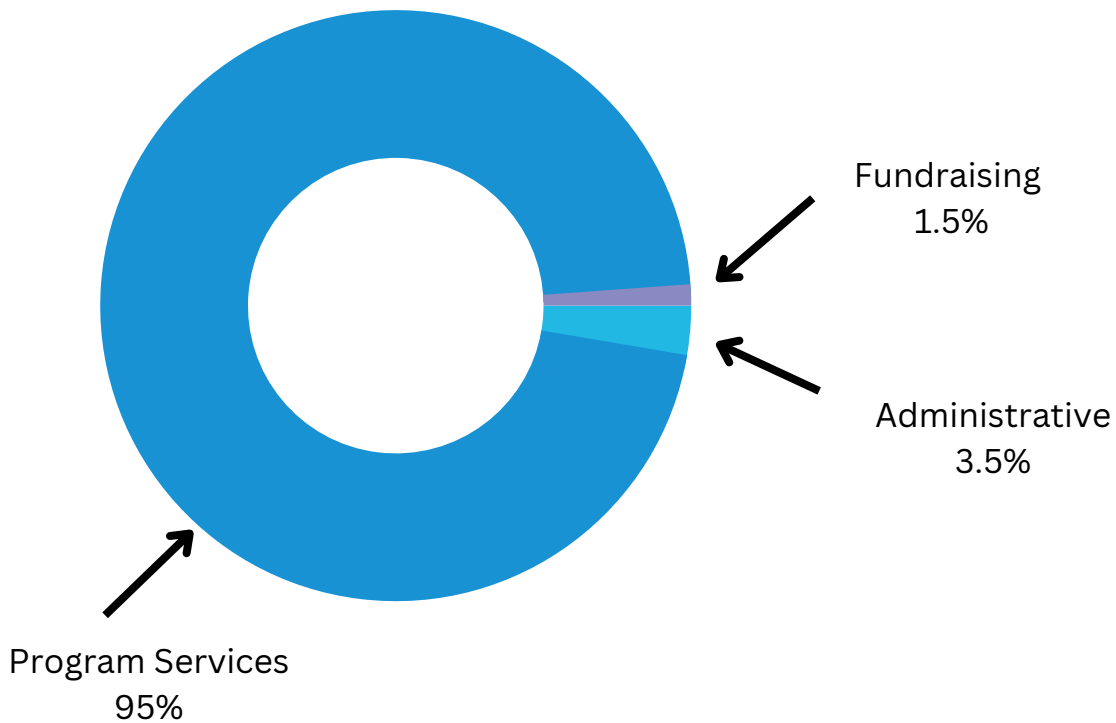
