Volunteers are the lifeblood of Maliheh Free Clinic's operations. In the past year, a remarkable total of 600 volunteers gave generously of their time, contributing 27,019 hours of service. Our ongoing tally since 2005 shows a profound commitment from our volunteers, with an astonishing 470,000 service hours donated.

Our volunteer roster is diverse and dedicated, encompassing doctors, nurses, physician assistants, medical assistants, physical therapists, interpreters, and clerical staff. Their collective efforts have facilitated healthcare provision to over 48,000 Utah residents through 245,000 unique patient visits since our inception in 2005. 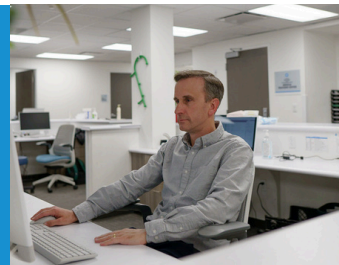

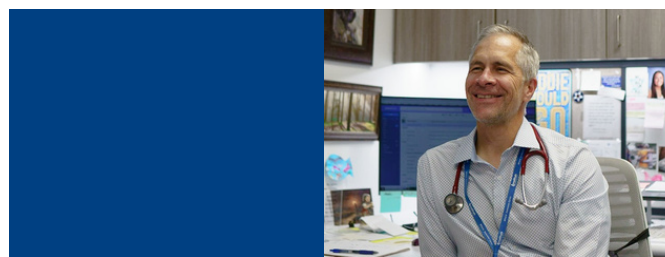
